## Apply for SNAP Benefits

Even if you work or have lost other benefits you can still get Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits! Some things people say are not true. Seniors can get more than \$16 a month in SNAP benefits!



### Apply if:

- You do not have a job
- You have a job but are still poor
- You are a US citizen or it is legal for you to live here
- You are disabled or have health problems that keep you from working

### To apply:

Go to your local SNAP office. You do not need to call first. If you need help finding your local office, call them. Outside NJ call 1-800-221-5689. In NJ you can also apply at: [www.NJHELPS.org](http://www.NJHELPS.org)
